This experience at sports is unlike any other. Participants have the opportunity to mingle with others their age. They don't have to worry about the score of the game, pleasing mom and dad, or having a coach yell at them.

There is no better way to start sports than on a positive note.

Each week the soccer stars are divided into groups of 3 and they play soccer. Encouragement is given from coaches, parents, and spectators. Lot's of pictures are

taken and each child feels like the star of the game. We then break for a small devotion and time to learn who Jesus is and what He did for us.

The next session includes fun games that help us learn basic soccer skills such as dribbling, shooting and passing. The games are very interactive and each child gets multiple touches on the ball in a controlled environment.



Concluding play Pleasant Hill Church provides popsicles for each participant and Lil T's Traffic Stop provides a memory verse for them to receive a special gift from Lil T's.
